Gamma Upsilon Omega Chapter of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated and Ivy Foundation of Hampton, Incorporated High School Book Scholarship Criteria

Eligibility Requirements

- Applicants must be a graduating Senior from a City of Hampton Public School (Bethel High School, Hampton High School, Kecoughtan High School, or Phoebus High School).
- Applicants must be interested in enrolling in a four (4) year college or university for the 2021-2022 school year.
- Applicants must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or higher.
- Applicant may be male or female.

Requirements

- 1. An official (sealed) high school transcript.
- 2. Completed sorority scholarship application should be typed in twelve (12) inch format.
- 3. Prepare a personal statement. The personal statement MUST include a central aspect of your identity such as activities of interest, talent(s) you have, and your cultural and family background). The statement should explain your reasons/rationale for receiving a book scholarship.
- 4. Two (2) letters of recommendation. One (1) letter from your school counselor and one (1) letter from your teacher. The recommendation letters MUST be typed in 12 inch font and signed with a professional signature.
- 5. Review the assigned <u>Essav Topics</u> within the scholarship application to prepare an essay consisting of a minimum of two hundred (200) words and a maximum of four hundred (400) words, double-spaced, typewritten in format of (Time New Roman) at twelve (12) inch font. The essay must include your name, your high school and the title of your essay topic in the right-hand upper corner of your submission.
- 6. Documented proof of participation within your high school and/or volunteer /community/ church activities.
- 7. Applicants for this scholarship will be asked to participate in a virtual interview process planned by the Scholarship Committee.
- 8. Include a formal <u>"cap and gown headshot"</u> photograph. If you take your own professional headshot the photograph should include a bright or natural light source and the background may be a simple wall, natural landscape or clutter free area. Please review the photograph release form included within this application and should be completed and signed with you *and* your parent and/or guardians' official signature.

Essay Topics

All applicants must submit an essay which addresses one (1) of the four (4) topics below:

- A. **Social Justice** What do you consider to be a current important societal problem within the United States of America? How do we overcome this problem? What would be the benefits and consequences of questioning or challenging this societal problem for your community?
- B. **STEM** Why is an education in the discipline of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) important to the sustained growth and stability of the United States economy? Describe how STEM innovates and impacts your everyday life?
- C. **Black World History** Discuss the historical purpose of "Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCUs) in America." Why were these schools initially created? Why are these schools still important today? Discuss four (4) specific myths about HBCUs that exist today. Define the "Missouri Effect" and the impact this effect has had upon HBCUs since the year 2016.
- D. Conflict and Resolution- Have you ever been treated unfairly because of your race, your religion, the way you look, or just because you are "different"? Unfortunately, many of us have. Give an explanation about a specific time you were treated unfairly. How did you react? How did it make you feel? How was the situation resolved?
